BLUE BADGE PARKING

When you arrive at the site, ask one of our lovely stewards to direct you to your Blue Badge priority parking area, and they'll steer you right. All vehicle parking on site is on grass. Please see camping section for notes on parking within camping areas.

GETTING AROUND THE SITE + PLANNING YOUR VISIT

The site is grassy and gently sloping towards the main stage. We have created maps (on the next pages) which show distances and gradients onsite so that you can plan your visit a little more easily. If you spot anything on there that you need more information on, don't hesitate to get in touch with us, we are happy to provide more detail about the site.

We don't currently have designated accessible access routes around the site, this is something we're working on as part of our long-term vision for a site that's fully accessible to all.

We have also marked the location of accessible WC facilities and our wheelchair accessible viewing platform.

Blue Badge priority areas have also been marked on the map. If you have mobility issues that require you to have minimal walking distances, please refer to this map.

TENT CAMPING

If you are camping in our general tent camping area, your ideal camping spot will depend on your needs. Please refer to the map to see locations of campsite entrances, trading area entrance, toilets, quiet/family area, and sloping ground. Camping spots in this area are not allocated and are chosen by you on arrival - tent camping for our Live in The Wyldes shows is usually very spacious.

PARKING - Vehicles are prohibited in this camping area, including for unloading baggage, so you will need to park in our car park before entry.



LIVE-IN VEHICLE CAMPING

If you are camping in our general live-in vehicle camping area, let a steward know on arrival if you require an accessible pitch, and they can guide you towards the best spot available. Pitches in this area are not pre-allocated.

PARKING - Depending on the size of your set up, you may be able to park one vehicle next to your main unit of accommodation.

**PREMIUM CAMPING (TENTS & LIVE-IN VEHICLES)**

If you are camping in Premium camping, let a steward know on arrival if you require an accessible pitch, and they can guide you towards the best spot available. Pitches in this area are not pre-allocated.

PARKING - Depending on the size of your set up, you may be able to park one vehicle next to your main unit of accommodation.

**GLAMPING**

If you are camping in our Glamping area, glamping pitches are pre-allocated. When you arrive stewards and signage will point you towards your bell tent.

Please note that Bell tent number 1 (name: Fleetwood) has wheelchair access, with a hardcore track and metal ramp onto the decking. All other bell tents have 1-2 steps up onto the decking. Please get in touch at office@thewyldesgroup.com for more information or to reserve this tent.

PARKING - Parking for the Glamping area is on grass in front of the area boundary. On arrival, a steward can point you towards the best parking spot for your bell tent. You can then carry your bags down the hardcore track to your tent. Vehicles are prohibited on the hardcore tracks within the Glamping area.

ACCESSIBLE FACILITIES + SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

PA/CARER TICKETS

Your allocated PA/carer tickets (if applicable) will be available to collect when you arrive on the event day from our Box Office. Please bring photo ID with you.

OUR WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBLE VIEWING PLATFORM

Our wheelchair accessible viewing platform is marked on the map included in this pack. If you have requested a space on the viewing platform, you will need to collect your platform pass from Box Office when you arrive on the day.

MEDICATION STORAGE

If you have medication storage requirements, please contact us directly so that we can help you with this.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

If you have already supplied supporting documents, you do not need to bring anything with you on the day. Please bring photo ID with you if you are collecting a PA/Carer ticket.
